Your First Visit to Our Office:
What to bring & what to expect

Bring the following INTO the office:

- All health insurance cards
- Driver's License or other Photo ID.
- The glasses you wear for DISTANCE vision (including driving or TV).
Please bring these into the office! Do not leave them in the car.
- Actual bottles of any prescription eye drops you are currently using
- List of medications (unless you have written out the full list on the New Patient Packet)

BE PREPARED for the following:

1. Expect your visit to take two hours or more.

Paperwork, registration, testing, dilation, and office flow will contribute to this timing. Also, we are a doctor's office and regularly see emergencies which can create delays for our routine patient exams.

2. If you want a new prescription for glasses or contact lenses:

First read our handout "Will Dr. Biser Measure Me for Glasses?"
This is in your New Patient Packet.

3. A dilated exam is recommended in most cases.

However, you have the right to avoid dilation at your visit. Dr. Biser will not dilate you unless you agree to it.

➔ If you are dilated, you may find driving difficult or impossible for several hours.

If you are not used to being dilated, it is best to arrange a driver or other transportation to return home.

➔ If you are dilated, you will probably find it difficult to read books, read cellphone texts, or work on a computer for several hours.

Most people with jobs requiring computer work or reading will find it difficult to impossible to work for several hours after dilation.

Parking

We have four parking spots right outside the building, on the Birch Street side. (Despite the large tow-away sign, parking is allowed if you have an appointment.) If all spots are filled, there is plenty of on-street parking nearby (both free and metered).
